

We are happy to Welcome All County Disposal Co. to the Village. They will be our new provider beginning the first week of May. Your service remains the same with the exception of Holiday Procedures All County Disposal Co. runs all holidays (yes, even Thanksgiving, Christmas & New Years!!)...we are never a day behind. You always want to put your trash out for your regular pick-up day.

We will continue to have three (3) refuse options:

- 1- Regular Service Each customer is limited to four (4) **40** gallon cans or five (5) **40** gallon bags per week. The cost will be \$11.40 per month. (22.80 each billing)
- 2- Toter Service All County Disposal Co. will provide a 95 gallon tote for an additional \$2.00 per month. The cost will be \$13.40 per month. (26.80 each billing)  
The weekly limit is the Toter plus 1 (30-gal) can or bag of your own.  
Toter Facts: A 95-gallon tote holds up to four (4) regular cans or bags and will keep your neighborhood cleaner on collection day. Additionally, these carts eliminate the need for lifting three (3) or four (4) heavy bags to the curb. The cart is easily wheeled to the curb on collection day.
- 3- Bag Program for those not needing weekly service. Cost is \$2.00 per bag. (sold in sets of 10) Bags are only available at the Town Hall.

We ask that you notify them in advance of large amounts being put at the curb. You will be charged for overages. This will be on your sewer/refuse bill from the Village.

All County Disposal Co. cannot take tires, batteries, yard waste (grass clippings, brush, branches, etc.), nothing with freon in it (refrigerators, air conditioners, humidifiers, etc.), no liquids, oils or paints.

If you live on the east side of town you will put your trash out on, Monday by midnight and the west side will put out on, Wednesday by midnight.
